We are also encouraging children to eat healthy snacks and start the day with a good breakfast. Please no chocolate, treats or sugary snacks for the children in the morning at daycare. If you are finding there isn't enough time to have breakfast at home children are welcome to have breakfast at daycare in the mornings.

We appreciate children being sent with appropriate outside wear. Thank you! Please continue to send warm clothing as we approach our wet winter season. This includes boots, jackets, mittens/gloves, muddy buddies, hats or toques.

Flu season is back! We understand the difficulty of finding alternate care for sick children, but the health of every child must be our first consideration. Please help us keep the germs away and keep your child home if they have a fever of 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit or higher, or if they have heavy "colored" runny nose or diarrhea. If your child is sent home from daycare due to illness please only return after 12 hours fever free (without medication) and 24 hours (symptom) free otherwise - and when your child is well enough to resume daily activities.

Last month at daycare we talked about Harvest and Apples, Thanksgiving, Fall and Halloween! This upcoming month we will be continuing learning about different types of Dinosaurs and all about space!

We will be **closed** Monday, November 11<sup>th</sup> for Remembrance Day!
